INDUSTRY MARKET OUTLOOK

Malaysia is rapidly strengthening its logistics sector through efficient customs processes, ASEAN FTAs, and digital trade platforms.

World-class ports like Tanjung Pelepas and Port Klang, plus the upcoming ECRL, boost regional connectivity. Smart Logistics Complex incentives are driving adoption of AI, IoT, and automation in hubs. Green logistics initiatives, including B20 biodiesel and sustainable infrastructure, are gaining traction. With steady 5%+ annual growth, Malaysia is positioning itself as a high-tech, sustainable logistics hub in Asia.

APAC will contribute to the maximum growth opportunities for companies throughout the predicted period (2020-2025).


According to this logistics market analysis, the growth of the e-commerce industry and initiatives by the governments of emerging economies including China, India, and Australia towards the development of transportation infrastructure, are major factors that will drive the logistics market share of APAC.

Malaysia's logistics market is on a solid growth trajectory.


The freight and logistics sector was valued at around USD 32 billion in 2024 and is projected to reach USD 53 billion by 2034, expanding at roughly 5.2% CAGR. Growth is being driven by rising e-commerce volumes, major infrastructure projects such as the East Coast Rail Link and ASEAN Express rail corridor, continuous port expansions at Port Klang and Tanjung Pelepas, and strong adoption of digital technologies under government incentives.


